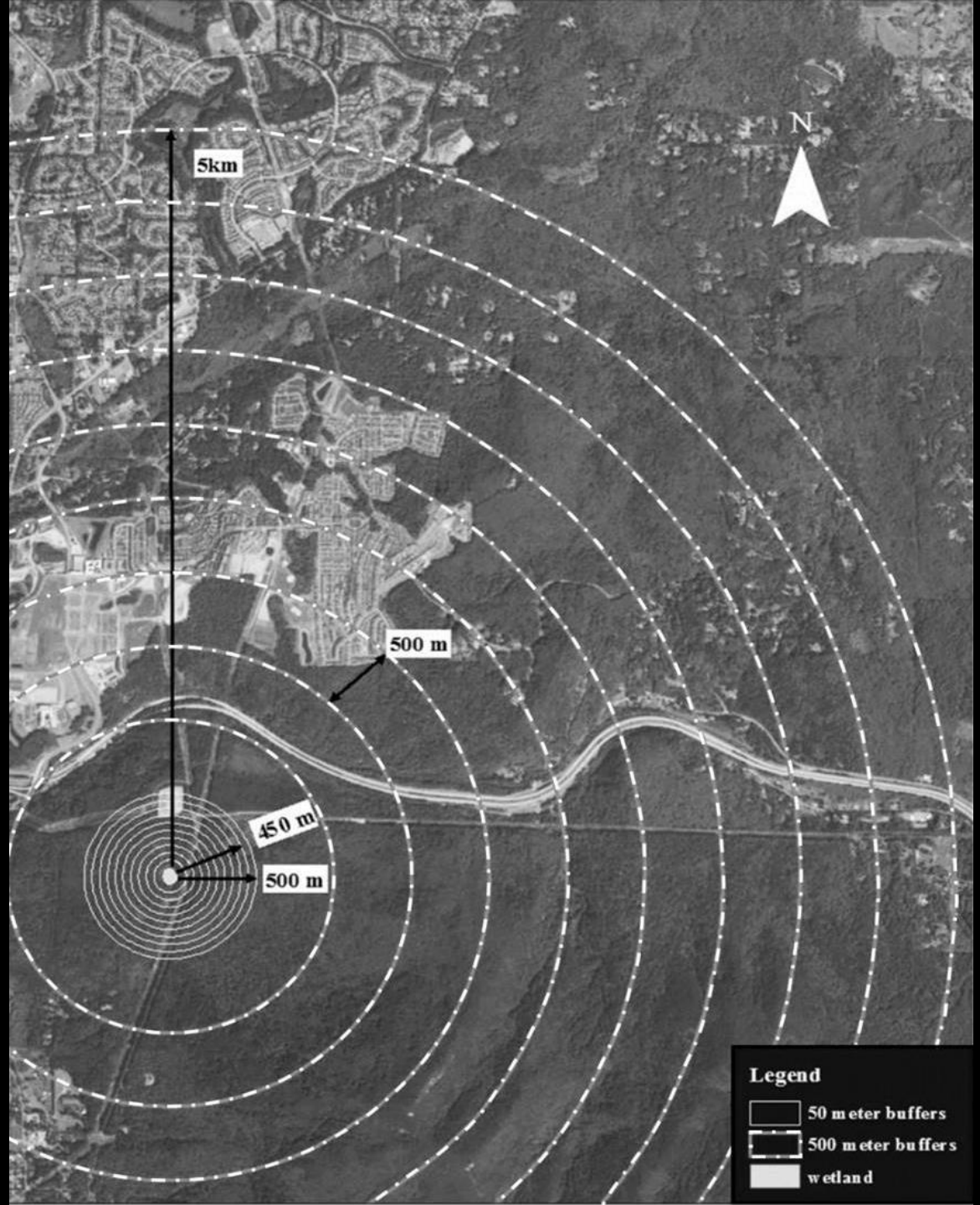

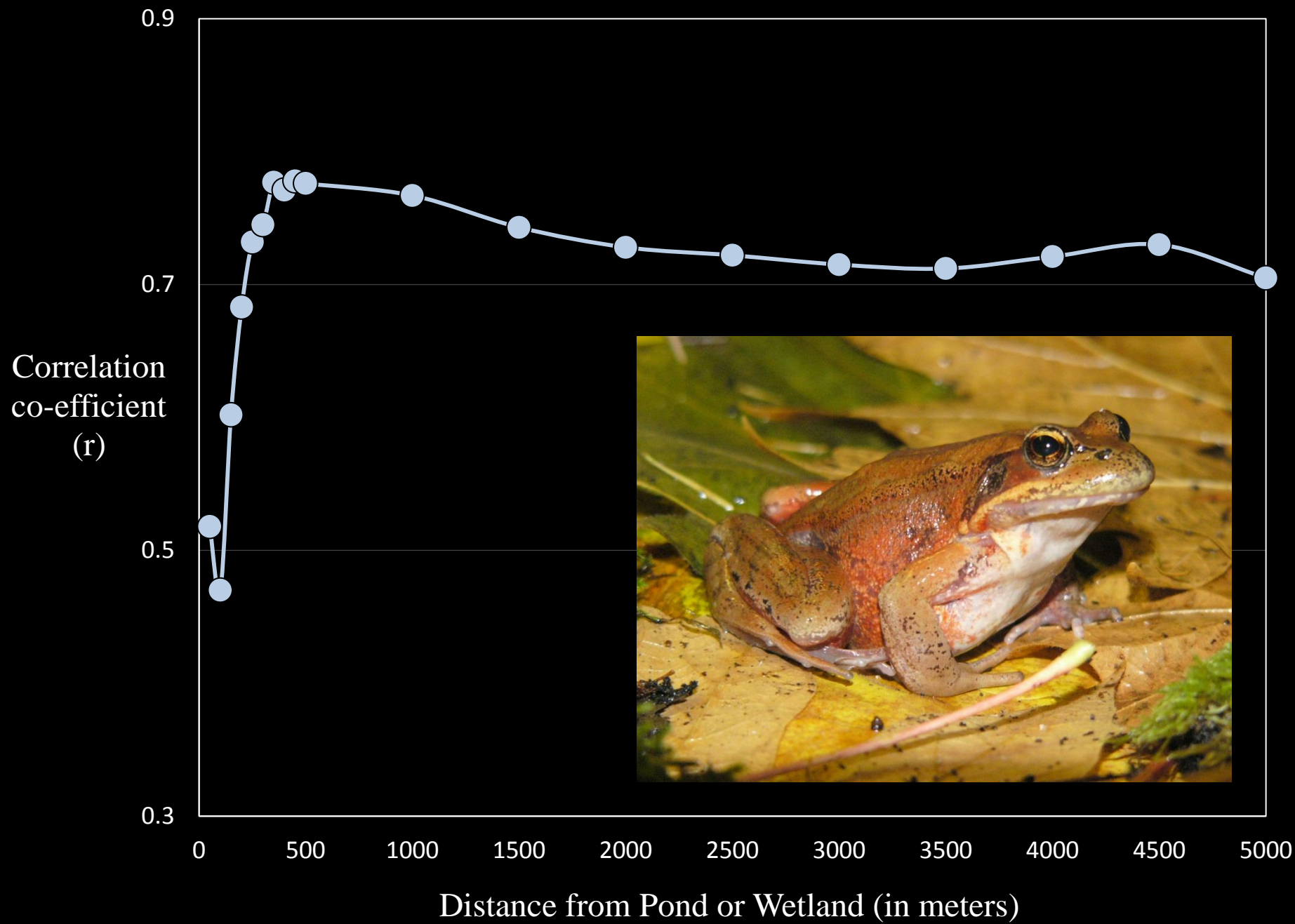
And We Focused

What Did These Data, Which Were Citizen Science-Collected, Allow Us to Conclude...

- 1) Most Northern red-legged Frogs move a long distance from breeding ponds
- 2) To maintain Northern red-legged Frogs on the Landscape, one needs large undeveloped patches
- 3) So in urbanizing landscapes, to ensure Northern red-legged Frogs remain on the landscape, one has to plan early in the development process to ensure that large undeveloped patches remain in perpetuity
